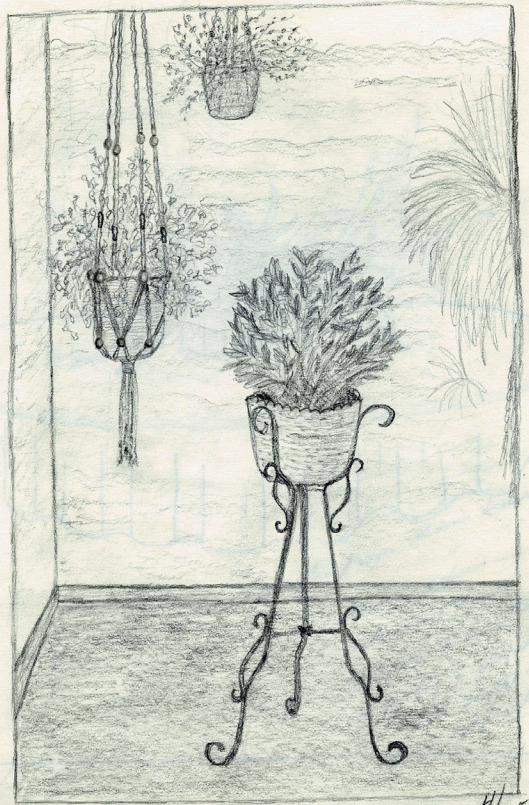
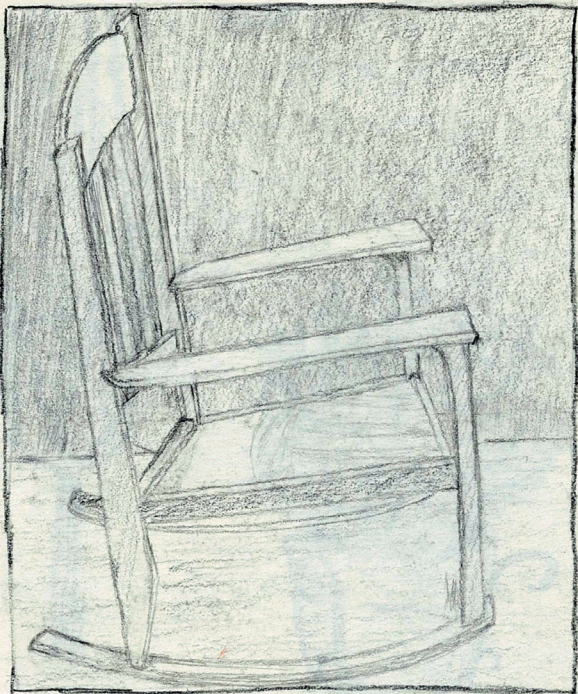




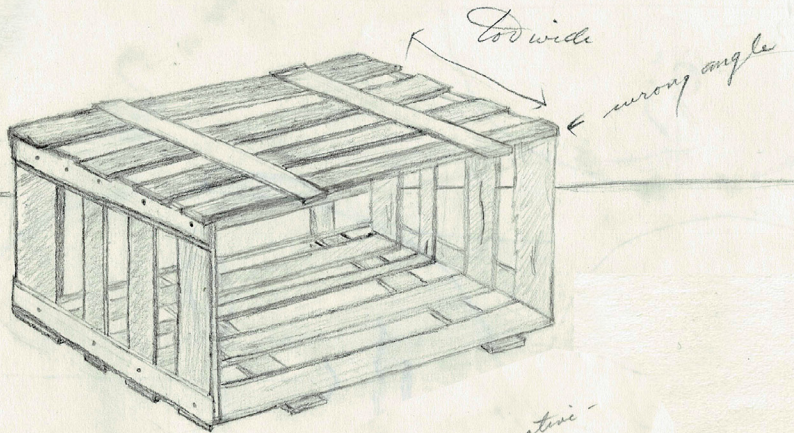
planter from Mom's funeral

 not a picture -

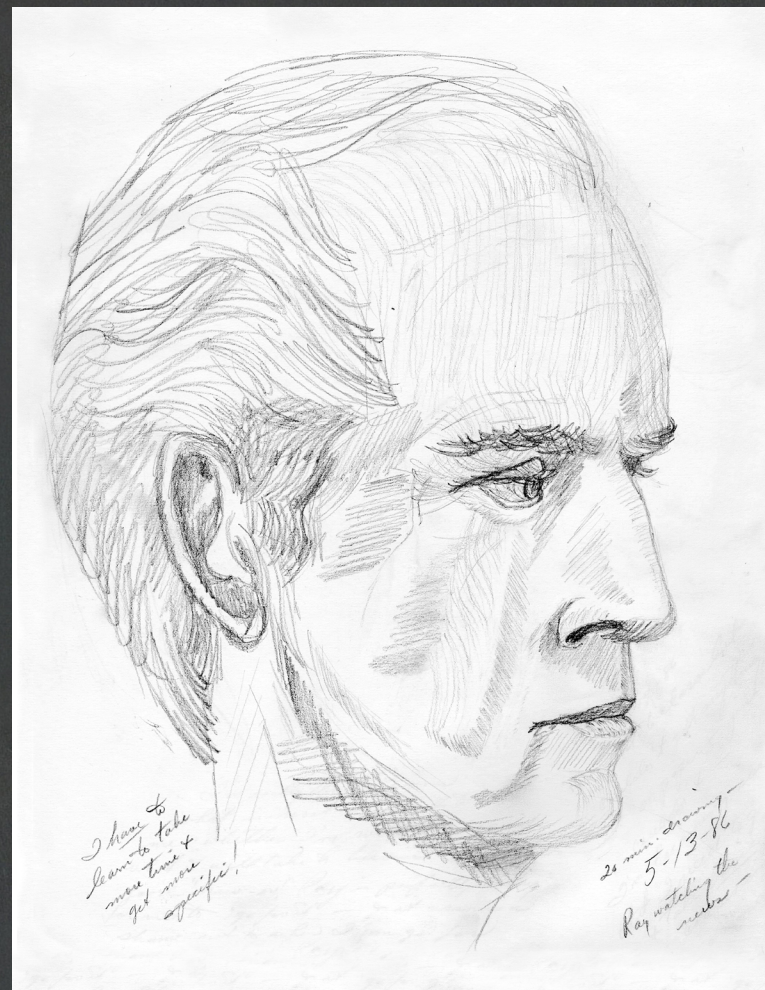
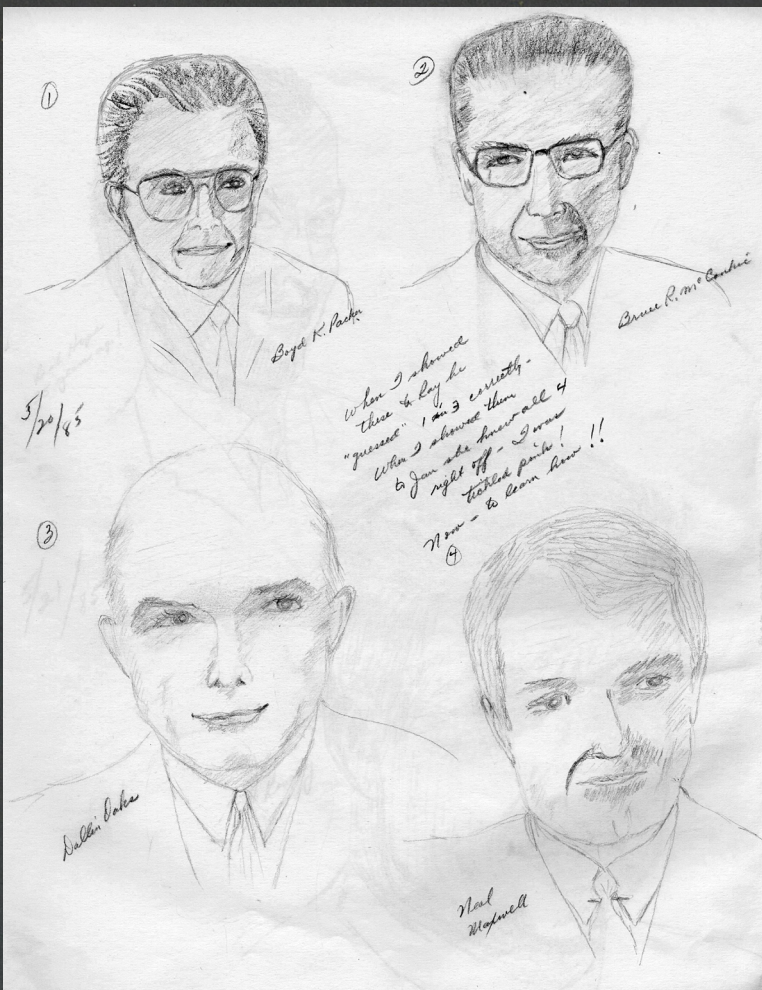
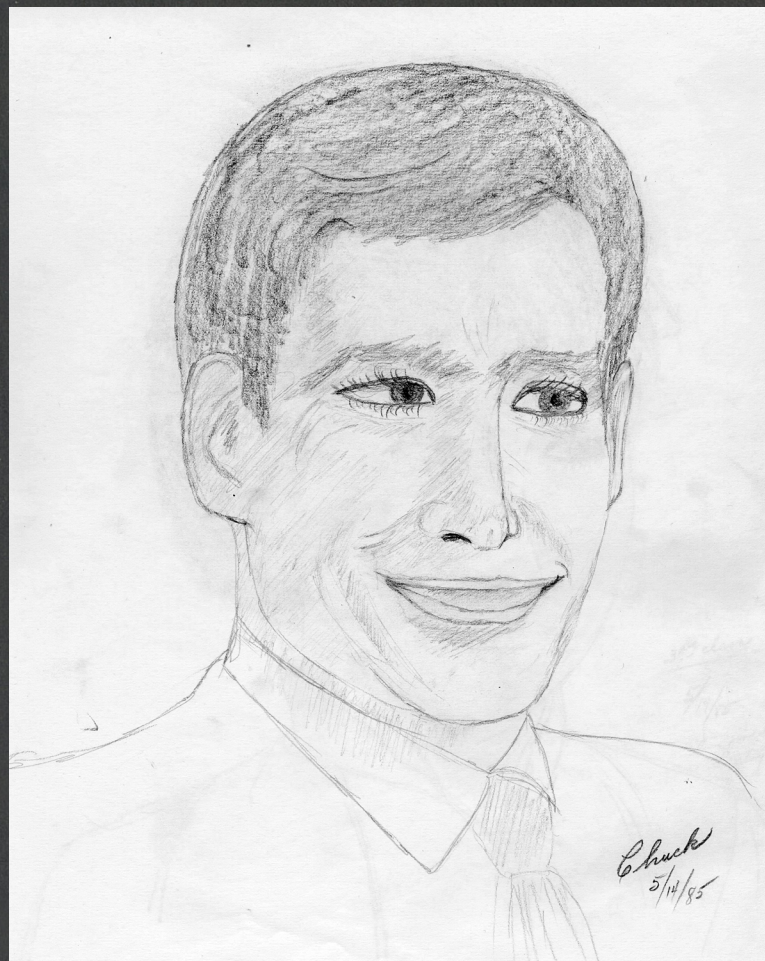
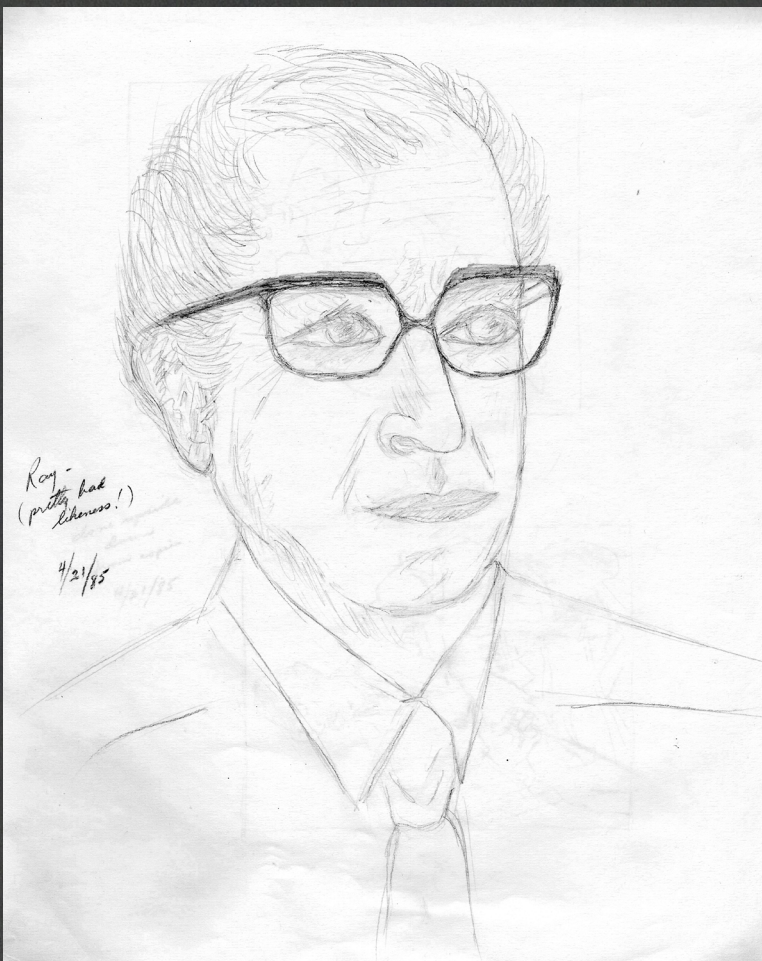


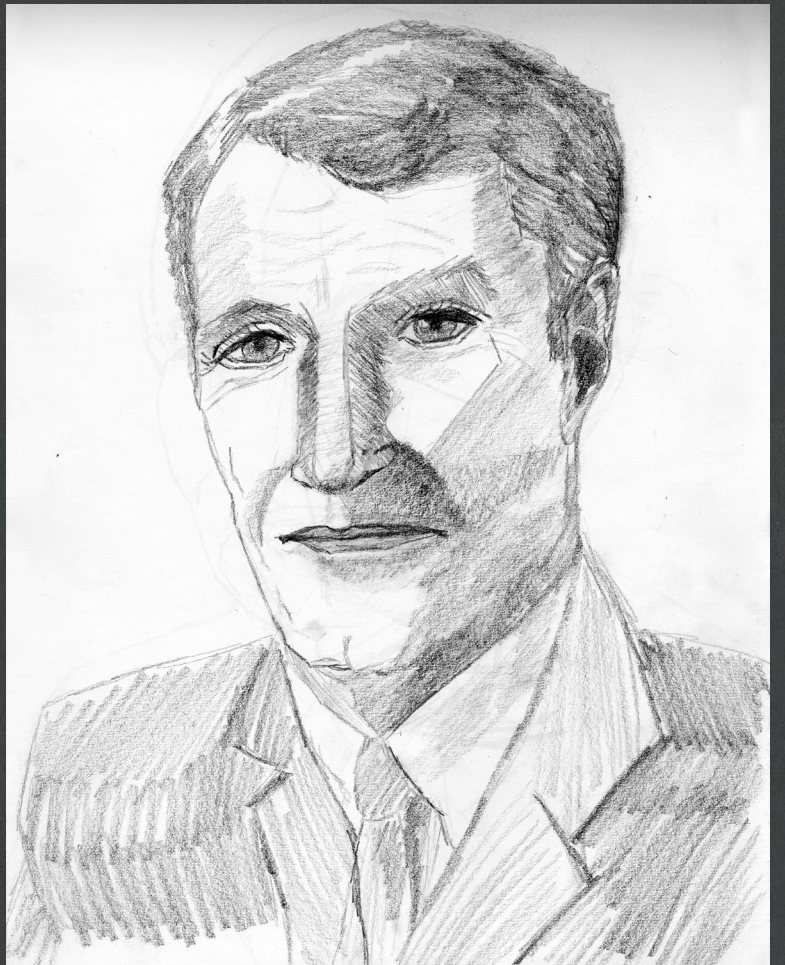
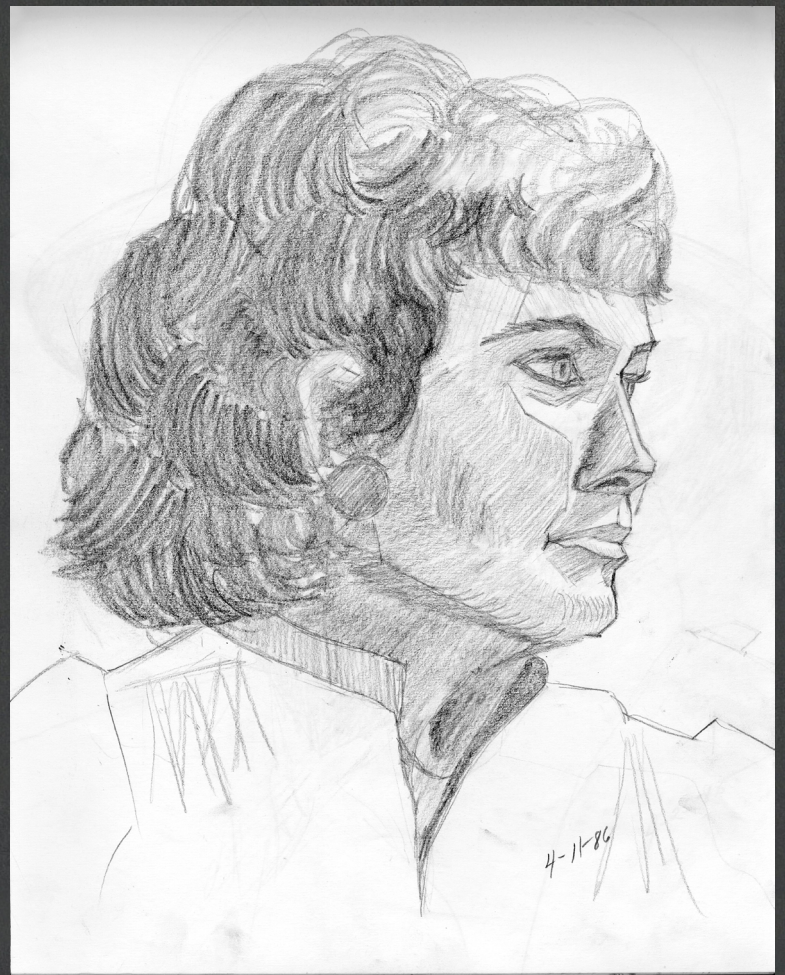
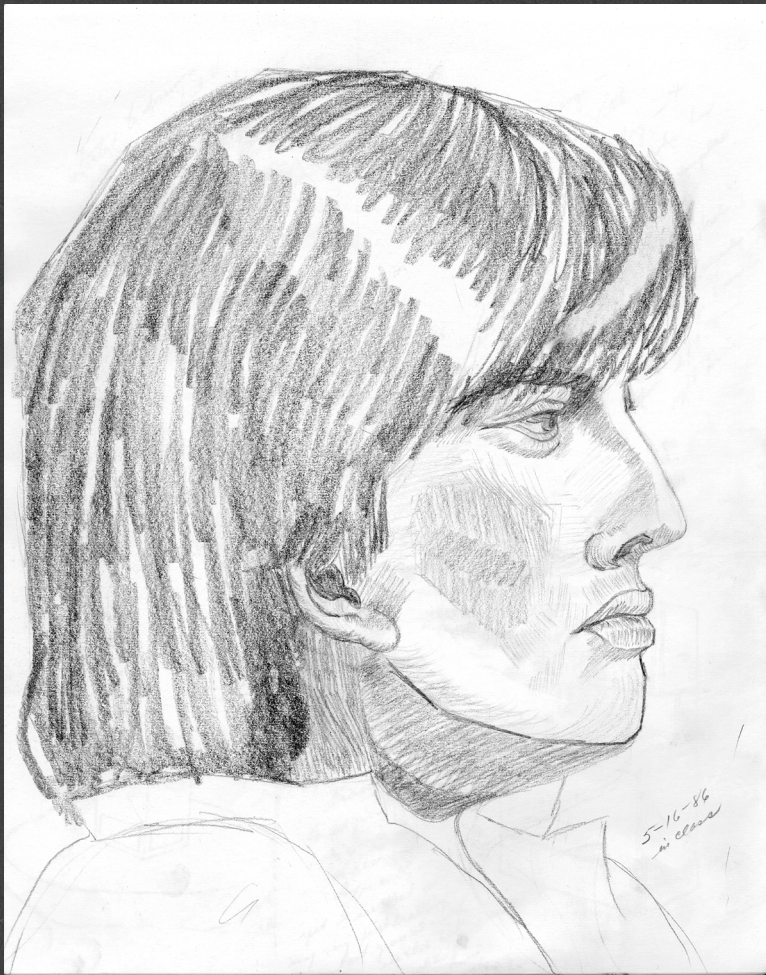

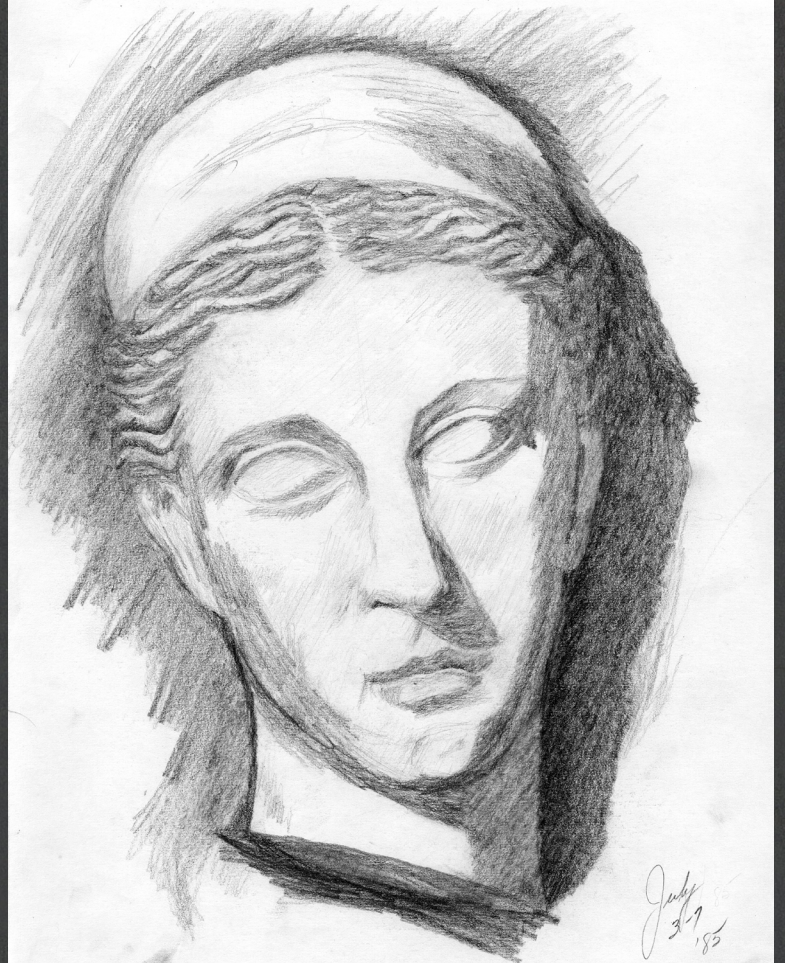
2nd lesson - talked about perspective -

 not enough value)



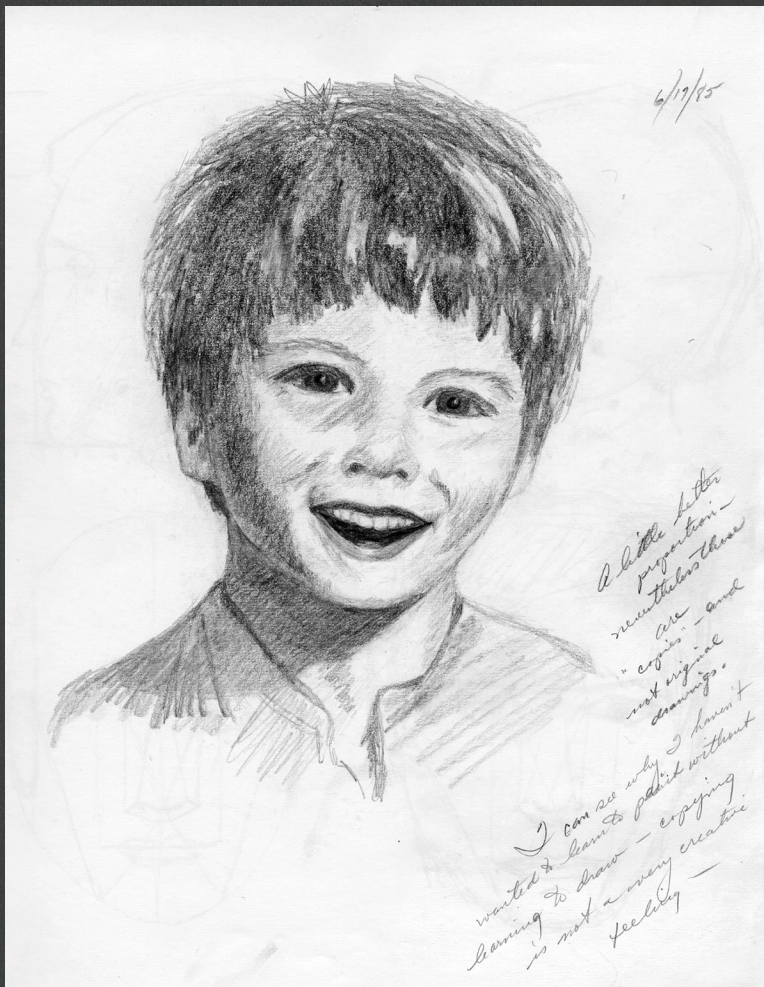

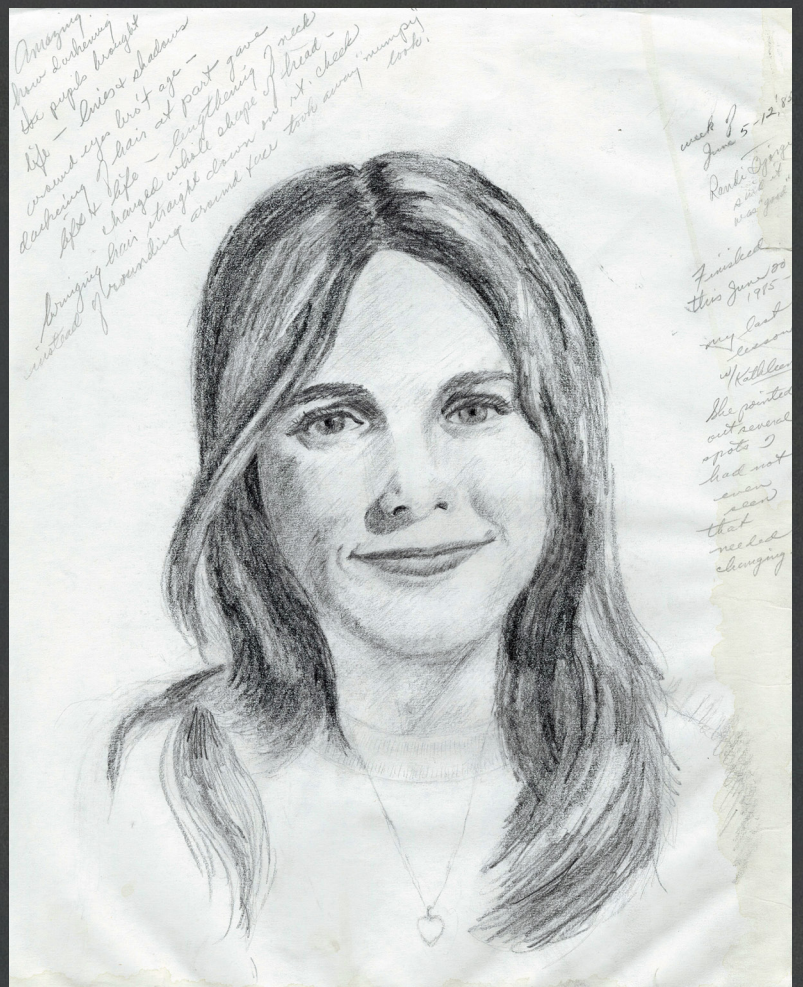
